The origin of this project was born from the experience of practitioners teaching primary and secondary pupils. The need to provide a curriculum in sex and relationship education that is authentic to the Church's teaching and acknowledges pupils' stage of physical and sexual development. Throughout the writing of the script and teacher-support materials the Department consulted with primary and secondary aged pupils.

The programme is split into 5 distinct sessions - **All that I am**, Key Stage 2 for Year 5 and 6 teachers, **Where I am**, Key Stage 3 for Year 7, 8 and 9 teachers, **How I am**, Key Stage 4 for Year 10 and 11 teachers, and finally **Who I am**, Key Stage 5 for Year 12 and 13 teachers.
